Specialists in boys' education

Teaching staff at Blackfriars are employed based on their achievements, qualifications and educational philosophies; in particular for their ability to convert curriculum into an engaging and inspiring experience for boys and young men.

Our teachers combine years of experience with contemporary teaching methodologies, up-to-date research and recent technologies to make learning enjoyable and purposeful.

Students at Blackfriars explore and excel in their natural strengths, build confidence to apply themselves to more challenging subject areas, co-construct learning and lay the foundations for lifelong learning and achievement.



Our Middle Years program caters to the diverse needs of boys in this transitional period of life. The contemporary curriculum for Years 7 to 9 is based on the Australian Curriculum, where teachers identify the needs of each student and create individual programs that encourage their development.

Senior School students undertake the internationally recognised South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) in Years 10



to 12. Students can opt for a fully academic program on the pathway to achieving an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) and tertiary studies, or a program rich in Vocational Education and Training, or a mixture of these.

Throughout their time at Blackfriars, boys have opportunities to further their learning and engagement through comprehensive electives and specialist programs and can immerse themselves in the full range of cocurricular activities on offer. We encourage all students to aspire to positions of leadership among their peers.



The success of Blackfriars educational programs is reflected in our end of year results. 90% of our international and local students are directly accepted into local and overseas universities. The foundation laid at Blackfriars makes for an easy transition to tertiary study with graduates pursuing a diverse range of undergraduate courses including Medicine, Science, Engineering, Law, Pharmacy, Business, Commerce, Finance and Marketing.

Student wellbeing

Blackfriars values a safe learning environment that nurtures the wellbeing of students and provides them with a place to achieve their optimum in all pursuits.



All Blackfriars students are allocated to a House where they meet and interact with students from other year levels and become involved in activities that promote friendly competition and cooperation.

Within their House, students are assigned a Home Group teacher who works closely with the student to provide academic and personal support.

Specialist counsellors are also available to assist students with specific personal matters, English language support and to provide advice about subjects and careers.

A home away from home

The Blackfriars homestay program immerses international students in Australian culture by placing them with a carefully matched local family.

With their homestay family, students experience Australian family life and hospitality while receiving the support you expect from home in a safe and encouraging environment.

The homestay family is an integral part of the student's Blackfriars community. While the school Principal has ultimate responsibility for all students, our International Student Liaison Officer meets regularly with international students to monitor their academic progress, homestay arrangements and personal development.


Blackfriars Priory School caters for the needs of many through meeting the needs of the individual.

Adelaide is a friendly, clean and safe city of approximately 1.3 million people. Adelaide enjoys a Mediterranean climate with temperatures of 15-20°C in winter months and 30-35°C in summer.

Blackfriars Priory School is located in the City of Prospect, 3km (5 minutes) from the centre of Adelaide. A Smart21 Community, Prospect is internationally recognised for its focus on economic development in the broadband economy.

Within a few minutes' walk of Blackfriars to world class swimming facilities and well-maintained parks and playing fields. Adelaide's pristine sandy beaches and picturesque foothills are less than 20 minutes from the school.
